OVERVIEW

The following activity sheets meet the achievement standard for the Foundation Year in the following areas:

- English many of the activity sheets support the developing knowledge of concepts about print and sound and letter as well as the use of rhyme, letter patterns and sounds in words.
- Mathematics many of the activity sheets support students in:
 - a) making connections between number names, numerals and quantities up to 10.
 - b) counting to and from 20 and ordering small collections.
 - c) grouping objects based on common characteristics and objects.
 - d) answering simple questions to collect information.
- Science many of the activity sheets support students in describing the properties and behaviours of familiar objects and how the environment affects them and other living things.

"Henny Penny" - Foundation Year has been specifically written to assist young children with learning the basic concepts that are required before formal education can commence. Doing, playing and singing are an integral part of a young child's learning process.
